

Start	transmitter	
1.	Make sure that the stop button is pressed.	
2.	Twist and pull out the stop button.	The top LED lights (green when the battery capacity is good, red when the battery capacity is poor), LEDs 3 and 4 flash (red).
3.	Press buttons 7 and 8 at the same time for at least 1 second.	LEDs 3 and 4 light (red).
4.	Release buttons 7 and 8.	LEDs 3 and 4 go out. The top LED flashes (green).




